GLOBAL PRECIOUS METALS CODE

"All LBMA members have attested their conformance with the Code by signing a Statement of Commitment.

The Code is intended to define a robust, fair, effective and transparent market where all participants are able to transact following <u>best practice</u> guidelines. It sets out a common set of principles to promote the integrity and <u>effective functioning</u> of the global market covering ethics, governance, compliance and risk management, <u>information sharing</u> and business conduct"

- Vaults still operate per individual Company policies and procedures
- Vault staff will still take in-house training

LBMA set out 'best practice' for a generic process

LBMA vault training platform provides external validation of operating skills and in-house training of those providing vault services

- Replace in-house training
- > Make you a 'London vault' ('approved', 'accredited', 'endorsed')

Review
